

## Lois Moore-Rogers Pediatric Otolaryngology Lectureship

The Lois Moore-Rogers lectureship was established in 1996 by Dr. Gerald Healy and the Department of Otolaryngology at the Children's Hospital Medical Center in Boston. Dr. Healy established this award to honor Lois who worked in pediatric Otolaryngology for 18 years. Lois has been a SOHN long-time member and the Pediatric Special Interest Group. During her years in practice, Lois concentrated on integrating the family unit when providing care. She was also interested in patient and family education.

Lois in conjunction with SOHN hopes the annual recipient of this award demonstrates innovation in ideas and comprehensiveness by including growth and development issues that impact on the family unit.

The recipient receives a cash award and a certificate.

### Guidelines for Submission:

1. The Presenter must be a current SOHN member
2. The presentation must be pediatric ORL oriented
3. The presentation clearly includes nursing implications
4. The Abstract (300 words or less), Teaching Plan Format with Target Audience, Purpose, Objectives with content, time frame, and teaching strategies for each objective, submitted typed, double-spaced (sample will be sent upon request, contact ENT-NF headquarters)
5. Biographical Data Form (sample also available upon request) or Curriculum Vitae
6. All required materials must be submitted to ENT-NF headquarters by **January 31st**
7. Written copy of presentation (typed, double-spaced) submitted by the Spring Meeting date same year for publication in **ORL-Head and Neck Nursing**.
8. The presentation must focus on one or more of the following aspects (points awarded for each)
  - Education patient/family focused
  - Ethical issues
  - Family oriented approach to care
  - Innovative nursing ideas
  - Integration/collaboration with multi-disciplines for complex patients
  - Nursing liaison role (inpatient/outpatient)
  - Quality improvement ideas/research
  - Teaching needs oriented to the child's growth and developmental level
9. Submissions for the lectureship will be judged by the President, Director of Education or designee, and a member of the ENT-NF Board of Directors appointed by the President. All reviews will be based on the set criteria.
10. In the event there are no submissions for this lectureship the National Education Planning Committee will invite a guest lecturer. Selection of the guest lecturer will be dependent on a submitted outline that supports the lectureship's purpose and reflects the criteria.
